

Environmental Policy Statement



Fusion Occupational Health Limited is committed to minimising the impact of its activities on the environment.

The key points of its strategy to achieve this are:

- Minimise waste by evaluating operations and ensuring they are as efficient as possible.
- Minimise toxic emissions through the selection and use of its fleet and the source of its power requirement.

- Consider all suggestions put forward to from internal staff and external advisors relating to reducing business waste and cutting pollution
- Commit to providing environmental leadership through all management levels and review and control of the organisation's environmental impacts
